ONE DAY VIRTUAL WORKSHOP ON GENDER EQUALITY

Prof. Miss Sneha W. Wagh Head Department of Botany expressed the vote of thanks of the workshop and in this way the workshop was over.

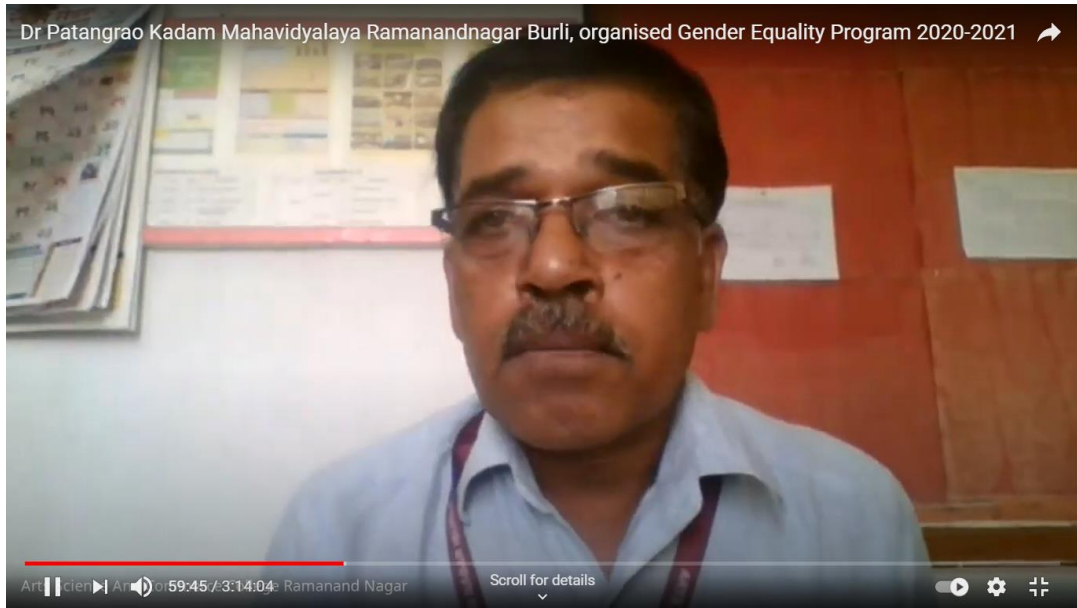
