


Respondent Profile



















































































4 Admission Process:






The feedback report shows that 43.2 % students felt that Admission process is excellent while 40.5% of the students felt it is very good and 18.9% of the students felt good.

Fee Structure:


Fee structure 37 responses




Infrastructure & lab Facilities 37 responses


Faculty 37 responses


Project Guidance 37 responses


Quality of support material 37 responses








Canteen Facility 37 responses




Hostel Facility 37 responses















How do you rate the course which are skill related suiting to the industry included into the programs?




How do you rate the learning experience in terms of their relevance to the real life application?








2. How do you rate developing activities organized by the Department/college/Institute for your overall development?


Willingness of the students to contribute to the development of the College:


Opinions of the students about Grievances/problems handled by the Department / College, a) as a student b) as an Alumni:
