



- > Physically handicapped students are eligible to get Govt. Scholarship.
- > B.C./OBC students failed in examination for One/Two times will get freeship.
- > Freeship for the students whose parents are employees of Rayat Shikshan Sanshta.
- > Freeship for the Ex-Servicemen's children.
- State Govt. open merit freeship (above 60% marks at H.S.C. exam is necessary)
- > Merit Scholarship for Economically Backward students.
- > Other Scholarship & Awards given by the Shivaji University & Rayat Shikshan Sanstha.



STUDENT'S CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

- **1.** Every student should have Identity Card with him in the college premises and should be produced on demand.

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Examinations and Assessment CBCS

The student should note that 80 percent attendance is must for theory and practical to become eligible for examination.

College will conduct internal/term end examinations as per norms laid down by Shivaji University Kolhapur .There is a semester (CBCS) pattern for all classes and bachelors and master degree courses. Whereas practical examinations is conducted annually.

In the credit based semester system under condition evaluation there will be an internal evaluation and semester end evaluation.

Beside the regular Shivaji University Kolhapur examination, college conduct internal examination for students one each at end of a semester and also provide home assignment to them as part of condition. Internal evaluation during the academic year for first year under graduate (UG) course (for all student)

SEE- semester end examination = 50 marks

For each course minimum passing for SEE is 18 out of 50 marks.

For second year under graduate (UG) course (for all subject)

SEE –SEMESTER END EXAMINATION =50 MARKS

For each course minimum passing for SEE is 18 out of 50 marks and the examination is conducted as per Shivaji university Kolhapur guidelines.

For third year under graduate (UG) course (for all subject)

SEE –SEMESTER END EXAMINATION 40 MARKS.

CCE- CONDITION COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION =10 MARKS

For each course minimum passing for SEE is 14 out of 40 marks .for CCE it is 4 out of 10

Marks .The overall passing is 18 OUT OF 50 Marks.

A module "Democracy, Elections and Good governance "is compulsory for first year degree course. First year degree course (UG) .if a student's fails to clear the examination in first year he/she can clear it within span of 3 year degree course .passing of this module is made compulsory by Shivaji University Kolhapur to gain degree certificate.

From academic year 2020-2021 compulsory Civic Course (CCC) constitution of India has been implemented by Shivaji University Kolhapur, for fifth semester students. This course is compulsory for all the faculties.



First and second year post graduate (PG) course – (for all students) SEE- SEMESTER END EXAMINATION 80 marks CCE-CONDITION COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION 20 MARKS

CCE = comprehensive measure such as attendance, home assignment, oral examination,pre semester, project work etc.

For each course minimum passing for SSE is 32 out of 80 marks and for CEE is 8 out of 20 marks. Overall passing is 40 out of 100 marks.


