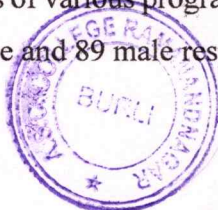
Design of Feedback:

- 6) Other

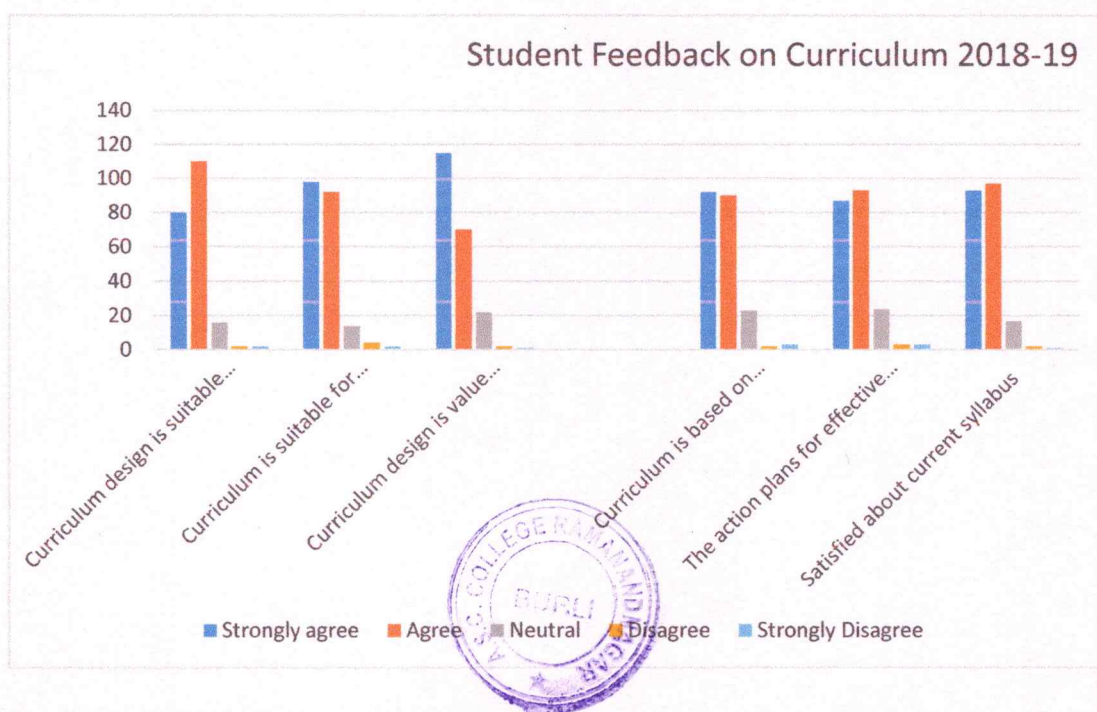
Student Feedback:

The respondent sample is broadly representative of the student population with respect to gender, programme level and course. We have received 210 students' online feedback on the syllabus of various programmes designed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur. There are 121 female and 89 male respondents in the survey sample.

About 38.09% students strongly agree and 52.38% agree with the current syllabus which is suitable for overall development of students. About 46.66% students strongly agree and 43.80% agree with the current syllabus which is suitable for employability. But there are 2.85% students who do not agree with it. About 43.80% students strongly agree and 42.85% agree with the current syllabus is value-based and is also based on national / regional values. About 97.14% students are satisfied with the action plan of implementation of curriculum. There are 90.47% students who are completely satisfied with current syllabus of the college, whereas 8.09% are satisfied however 1.42% are not satisfied.

All the parents who participated in this survey are satisfied with the curriculum selected by their children's. There are about 80% parents who agree that curriculum is practical knowledge based and are satisfied with it. 90% parents agree with the point that the curriculum of college is value-based and imparts regional and national needs (83.33%).
