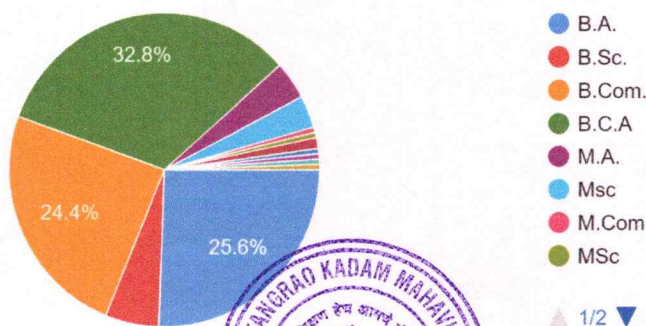
Introduction and Objectives:

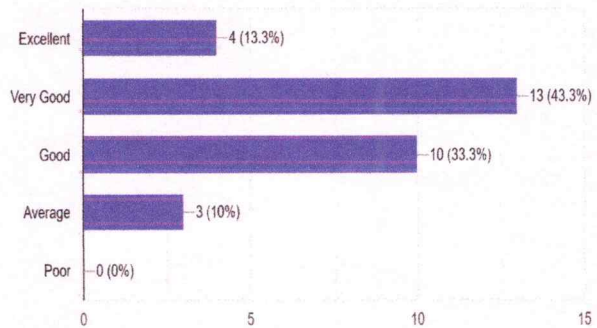

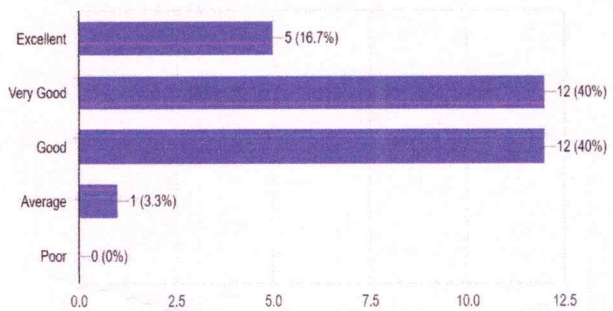
Infrastructure & lab Facilities

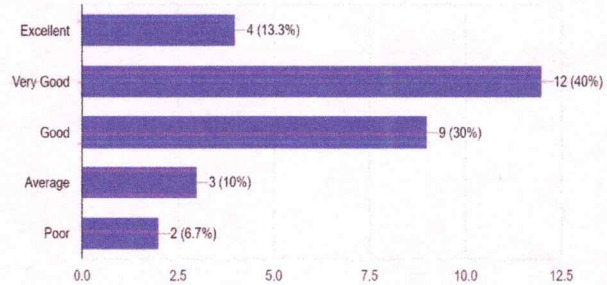

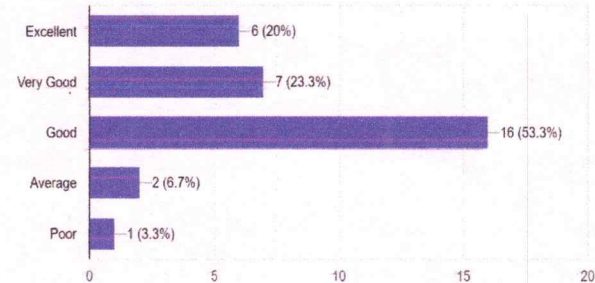
Canteen Facility

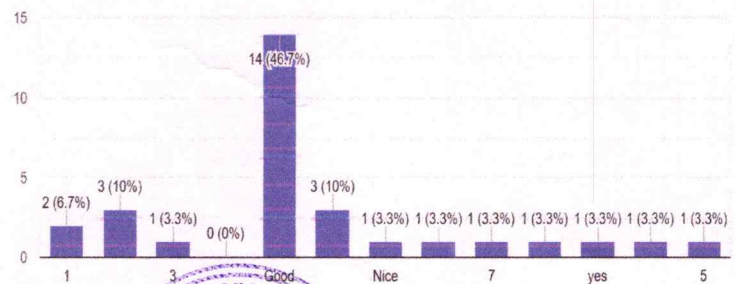
Hostel Facility

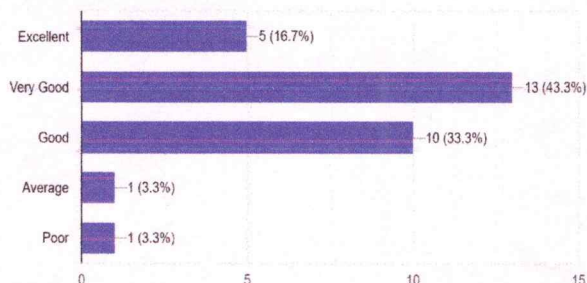
5e. Sports and cultural Facilities,

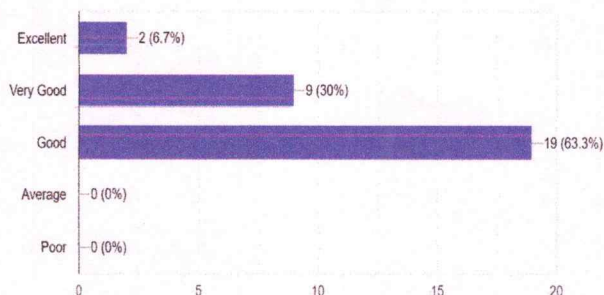
What is the caliber of students passing out of this institute

7. How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in relations to your current job?

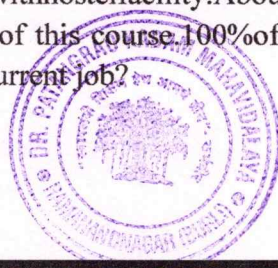

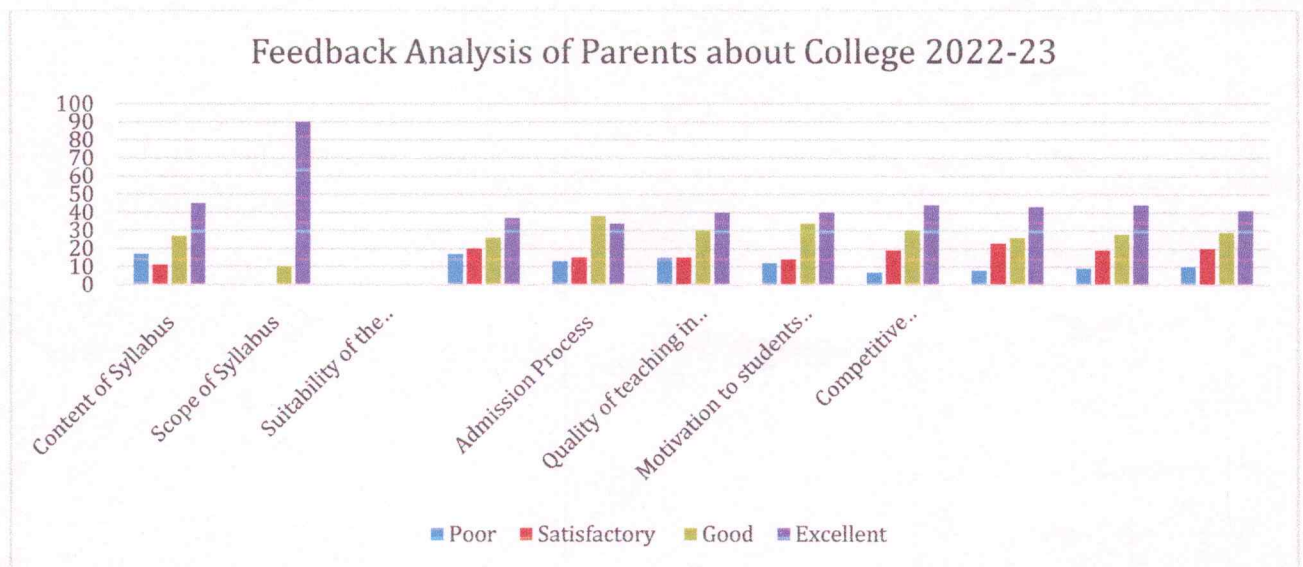
